June 10, Wednesday, DAY 1: Depart U.S.A.

We depart Pensacola International Airport on an overnight flight to Toulouse. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the plane. Quotes for add-on flights from different airports, as well as optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades, are available upon request and will be provided starting 120 days before departure. Group air restrictions (for ten passengers traveling together) do not permit specific seating requests on flights. We recommend purchasing your own airline tickets and land-only packages with us if seat confirmation is an important part of your trip. Should you require any additional information, please do not hesitate to contact your trip Account Manager, who will be happy to assist you.

June 11, Thursday, DAY 2: TOULOUSE - LOURDES

Welcome to France! Our English-speaking tour manager will meet the group at the airport and assist with boarding the bus. Upon arrival, we visit Toulouse, the third-largest city in France, with its numerous cafes, museums, and cathedrals. Here, St. Dominic founded the "Order of Preachers" in 1215. We visit the tomb of St. Thomas Aquinas at the Jacobins Church and spend time in its peaceful cloister before celebrating Mass. Following leisure time for lunch, we drive to Lourdes and settle into our hotel within walking distance of the Shrine of Our Lady. Dinner is at the hotel. (D)

June 12-13, Friday and Saturday, DAYS 3 & 4: LOURDES

We are blessed to have two full days of pilgrimage in Lourdes, including daily Mass, watching the video presentation about the story of Lourdes, exploring the birthplace of St. Bernadette, and visiting the places associated with her life. We pray the Stations of the Cross, drink the water from the miraculous spring, and immerse ourselves in the healing waters of the baths. In the afternoon, we can join the 5 PM

blessing of the sick and Blessed Sacrament, and in the evening, join the 9 PM Candlelight Procession at the Shrine. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (B.D)

June 14, Sunday, DAY 5: LOYOLA

We depart for Loyola, St. Ignatius's childhood home. The tour culminates with Mass and a private visit to the room where Ignatius experienced his spiritual conversion. We visit the basilica adjacent to the castle, which forms part of the Sanctuary of Loyola. In the afternoon, we travel to the Hermitage of Olatz and Aranzazu, a popular shrine to Our Lady, where St. Ignatius prayed for strength to overcome his former temptations. Dinner and overnight in the Pamplona area. (B.D)

June 15, Monday, DAY 6: PAMPLONA

This morning, we visit Pamplona, the birthplace and childhood home of St. Francis Xavier, a great 16th-century evangelist. After the Battle of Pamplona, young St. Francis Xavier was sent to the University of Paris, where he met his future roommate, Ignatius, with whom he would later co-found the Society of Jesus. We visit the site where St. Ignatius was wounded defending the city against the French in 1521. We visit Xavier (Navarre), where we will tour the castle where Francis Xavier was born. It contains a sculptured Crucifix, "the Smiling Christ". Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in the Pamplona area. (B.D)

June 16, Tuesday, DAY 7: ZARAGOZA

We drive to Zaragoza to celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady of Pilar, built to commemorate the place where the Virgin Mary, standing atop a pillar carried by Angels, appeared to St. James. The basilica's small, wooden statue of Our Lady of Pilar has been a regular stopping point for pilgrims now and during Ignatius's life. Dinner and overnight in Zaragoza. (B.D)



June 17, Wednesday, DAY 8: MANRESA - BARCELONA

This morning, we travel to Manresa, a place of profound conversion for Ignatius, to visit the Cave of Saint Ignatius, where the saint retired to meditate and write his Spiritual Exercises. We see the Chapel of the Rapture, where St. Ignatius remained motionless in ecstasy for eight days, and visit the Basilica of La Seu, the large Gothic church that has come to symbolize Manresa. We have an audiovisual presentation and a tour of the museum in Manresa. St. Ignatius remained in Manresa for about a year and a half before continuing his journey to Barcelona. We celebrate Mass in Manresa. In the afternoon, we drive to Barcelona for dinner and an overnight. (B.D)

June 18, Thursday, DAY 9: MONTSERRAT - WINE TOUR

We drive up to the mountains to the magnificent Montserrat Monastery, where we celebrate Mass and explore the Shrine of Our Lady. Since the 12th century, pilgrims have been drawn to the mountain to venerate the miraculous statue of the Black Madonna. According to Catholic tradition, the Black Virgin of Montserrat statue was carved by St. Luke around 50 AD and brought to Spain. It was later hidden from the Moors in a cave and rediscovered by shepherds in 880 AD. It is believed that the founding of the Society of Jesus by St. Ignatius of Loyola was inspired by the apparition of the Black Madonna to St. Ignatius during his pilgrimage to the Shrine of Montserrat. We visit the museum

containing works by great artists such as Caravaggio, El Greco, Rusiñol, Cases, Picasso, and Dalí. We enjoy a wine tasting in the area before dinner at leisure, with the opportunity to taste tapas at a local restaurant or visit the Mercat de Sant Josep de la Boqueria, a food market located in the Ramblas section of the city. Overnight in Barcelona. (B)

The day begins with a visit to the almost-finished masterpiece by Antoni Gaudí, La Sagrada Família, the Basilica of the Holy Family (TBC). Our next stop is the Basilica of Santa Maria del Mar, made famous in the novel and the Netflix series Cathedral by the Sea. In the afternoon, we enjoy time at leisure to explore Barcelona on our own. We celebrate Mass. Tonight we enjoy a farewell dinner accompanied by wine and a Flamenco dance performance. Overnight in Barcelona. (B. Flamenco Show and dinner)

June 20, Saturday, DAY 11: RETURN TO USA

After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our return flight home. (B) $\,$



PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Trip price is based on a minimum of 20 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.20 per Euro is assumed. *A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

SOLO ROOM: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/travel accident insurance for every passenger to protect their investment (all payments are non-refundable 60 days before departure). If you require very specific seats, we suggest you take advantage of the "Land Only" option and book your own airfare. Airline ticket name changes due to missing, incorrect, or incomplete information provided during registration will result in fees of at least \$350 per traveler. Switching reservations from Air and Land to Land Only within 100 days of departure will incur a minimum fee of \$150.00 per person. Quotes for Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request, as are add-ons from your hometown airport.
