### March 16, Monday, Day 1: DEPART USA

Depart New York/JFK or Orlando International Airport on an overnight flight to Paris. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Quotes for add-on flights and optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades are available upon request. Group air restrictions do not permit specific seating requests on flights. We recommend purchasing your own airline tickets and booking the Land Only package if seat location is important to you.

### March 17, Tuesday, Day 2: PARIS – LISIEUX

“Bienvenue en France!” Upon arrival at Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport, we are greeted by our English-speaking tour manager, who will accompany us throughout our entire journey. Relax on a scenic two-hour drive to Lisieux, the cherished home of St. Thérèse of Lisieux, “the Little Flower.” We delve into her profound spirituality with visits to the Carmel Convent and Les Buissonnets, her humble family home. We also celebrate our first Mass together, setting the spiritual tone for our pilgrimage. After we check into our hotel, enjoy some time to refresh before dinner. Overnight in Lisieux. (D)

### March 18, Wednesday, Day 3: NORMANDY'S SACRED SHORES

After breakfast, our day begins with a visit to the magnificent Basilica of St. Thérèse and its Crypt in Lisieux. Then, a picturesque drive through the French countryside leads us to the hallowed grounds of the Normandy Beaches. Here, along 54 miles of Atlantic coastline, we feel the weight of history at sites forever etched with the courage of Allied forces on D-Day, June 6, 1944. We reflect at Omaha Beach and the solemn American Memorial and Cemetery, paying tribute to the brave soldiers who secured freedom. We celebrate Mass near Omaha Beach, remembering the sacrifices made there. Return to Lisieux for dinner and an overnight stay. (B,D)

### March 19, Thursday, Day 4: ROUEN – PARIS

Following breakfast, we journey to Paris, with a captivating stop in Rouen to walk in the footsteps of St. Joan. Explore Rouen's beautifully restored medieval quarter and admire the stunning Gothic Notre-Dame Cathedral, a favorite subject of Claude Monet. We tour the city on foot, celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Joan, and see the historic site where she met her tragic end. We continue to Paris and settle into our hotel. Tonight, dinner is at leisure, offering the perfect opportunity to discover the charm of a Parisian café. Overnight in Paris. (B)

### March 20, Friday, Day 5: PARIS

After breakfast, we embark on an immersive city tour of Paris. We marvel at the newly rebuilt Notre-Dame Cathedral, a testament to resilience, and enjoy a panoramic tour of iconic landmarks including the Eiffel Tower. Our journey continues to the artistic Montmartre district, where we discover its bohemian spirit and visit the breathtaking Sacre Coeur Basilica and celebrate Mass. Tonight, prepare for a magical experience: a dinner cruise on the Seine River. As we glide past the magnificently lit buildings, the city's beauty unfolds before us, culminating in the dazzling light show of the Eiffel Tower. (B. Dinner cruise)

### March 21, Saturday, Day 6: LOURDES

This morning, we begin with Mass at the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal and behold the incorrupt body of St. Vincent de Paul at the chapel of Maison-Mère. Then, we board the high-speed TGV bullet train for a spiritual journey to Lourdes, a profound sanctuary of faith and healing. Upon arrival, we transfer to our hotel. After dinner, join pilgrims from around the world in the inspiring Candlelight Procession, a genuinely moving experience. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (B,D)

Our day in Lourdes is dedicated to spiritual reflection and meditation. We celebrate Mass, visit the sacred Basilica and the Grotto, where Our Lady appeared to St. Bernadette, and partake in the miraculous spring water, a source of healing for countless pilgrims. We also explore Boly Mill, St. Bernadette's birthplace, and the Cachot, the abandoned prison where her family once lived. In the afternoon, pray the Stations of the Cross and participate in the comforting Blessing of the Sick. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (B.D)

### March 23, Monday, Day 8: LOURDES – AVILA

We depart this morning, driving to Avila, the magnificent walled city dedicated to St. Teresa of Avila. Here, the atmosphere has changed very little since the days of St. Teresa, to whom the city is dedicated. St. Teresa, the renowned mystic, was the first woman to be named a Doctor of the Church. We visit the crypt of La Santa Convent, built on the site of the house where she was born; La Encarnacion Convent, where St. Teresa became a nun and home to the most comprehensive museum dedicated to her life; the Cathedral and the Cuatro Postes (four columns) which commemorates when St. Teresa, at the age of seven, convinced her brother to run away with her to die as martyrs in the land of the Moors. Their uncle caught them at the Cuatro Postes site and returned them home. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Avila. (B.D)

### March 24, Tuesday, Day 9: FATIMA

Today, we journey through Spain en route to Portugal. Late in the afternoon, we arrive in Fatima, one of the most visited pilgrimage sites in the world, renowned for the story of the apparition of Our Lady to three shepherd children in 1917. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Fatima. (B.D)

### March 25, Wednesday, Day 10: FATIMA

We start the day with Mass at the Basilica. We stop at the parish church where the visionaries were baptized and other places associated with their young lives, including the cemetery where the children are buried and their homes in Aljustrel. We travel to Valinhos and visit the site where the Holy Virgin appeared in August 1917, the outdoor Stations of the Cross erected by Americans, and the beau-

tiful Shrine of the Crucifixion, built on the highest point by Hungarian refugees. Tonight, we participate in the Candlelight and Blessed Sacrament Procession. Dinner and overnight in Fatima. (B.D)

### March 26, Thursday, Day 11: SANTARÉM – LISBON

Following breakfast, we depart for Santarem to venerate the Miracle of the Eucharist. We continue to the capital of Portugal, Lisbon, one of the most beautiful and historic cities in Europe. Located on the River Tagus, Lisbon is a vibrant city full of life, color, and fascinating places. We see Belem Tower, the longest bridge in Europe, and the impressive 300-foot-high statue of Christ the King. We continue to the magnificent Church of St. Anthony and celebrate Mass. Tonight, enjoy a farewell dinner accompanied by wine in a local restaurant. Overnight in Lisbon. (B. Special dinner)

### March 27, Friday, Day 12: RETURN TO USA

After breakfast, we are transferred to Lisbon Airport for our flights home. Lunch and a snack will be served on the plane. (B)

**PILGRIMAGE PRICES:** Trip price is based on a minimum of 20 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.18 per Euro is assumed.

**SOLO TRAVEL:** A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

**LAND-ONLY OPTION:** Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

**TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY:** Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

Switching reservations from Air and Land to Land Only within 100 days of departure will incur a minimum fee of \$150.00 per person. Quotes for Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request, as are add-ons from your hometown airport.
