

April 27, Monday, Day 1: DEPART THE U.S.A.

Depart this evening on an overnight flight to Rome from Denver International Airport. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Add-on flights and optional premium economy and business class rates are available upon request. (Please note: specific seat assignments are not possible with group air. You may choose to book your own air if seat location is a priority)

April 28, Tuesday, Day 2: WELCOME TO ITALY - ROME

We are greeted at the airport by our Italian Tour Manager who will be with the group the entire time. Our first stop is the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, where we celebrate Mass. Next we visit the Convent of Tre Fontane, where St. Paul was beheaded and the Shrine of Our Lady of Revelation nearby. Settle into your hotel for dinner and a night of well-deserved rest. Overnight in Rome. (D)

April 29, Wednesday, Day 3: PAPAL AUDIENCE – CHRISTIAN ROME

We make our way to the Vatican this morning and take our seats at St. Peter's Square as we wait for the Holy Father Pope Leo to appear in the Pope Mobile and bless us during the Papal Audience. Following lunch we visit the "Eternal City," where three millennia of Mediterranean civilization co-exist, in full of larger-than-life monuments, which you see during the Ancient and Christian Rome tour. We see the Basilicas of St. Mary Major, St. John the Lateran, the Holy Stairs, and Holy Cross in Jerusalem. Mass is celebrated at St. Mary Major. Overnight in Rome. (B. Special Lunch. D)

April 30, Thursday, Day 4: VATICAN TREASURES

Our day starts with a visit to St. Peter's Basilica, where we celebrate Mass and walk a short distance to the Vatican Museum for a guided tour. Enjoy seeing the incomparable masterpieces, including the Sistine Chapel. Following a guided visit to St. Peter's Basilica and the Scavi Museum (TBC) we have time at leisure to explore the city on our own. Perhaps continue to visit some of the many churches of the city, explore the nearby Trastevere section or enjoy a long leisurely lunch. The afternoon is yours to plan. Overnight in Rome. (B)

May 1, Friday, Day 5: CATACOMBS - BAROQUE ROME

This morning we visit the Catacombs, where the early Christians buried their dead and prayed in secret. Mass will be celebrated. Following a lovely lunch in a restaurant near the Catacombs, we return to Rome for a walking tour, which includes the Pantheon, Piazza Navona, Santa Maria Sopra Minerva, and the Gesu Church. You may want to visit the Trevi Fountain and the Spanish Steps, both of which are located in the area. Dinner is at leisure. Overnight in Rome. (B. Special lunch)

May 2, Saturday, Day 6: ORVIETO - ASSISI

We say goodbye to Rome, departing for Assisi. En route, we stop at the magnificent hilltop town of Orvieto, famous for its wine and the cathedral, considered one of Italy's most beautiful. Upon arrival in the town, where we see the dodecagon, a rare and unique figure, at Sant' Andrea Church on Piazza Republican, in the form of a twelve-sided bell tower. We visit the Cathedral and see the Miracle of the Eucharist of Bolsena. We celebrate Mass at the Basilica. Our day includes a wonderful lunch and a taste of the famous Orvieto Classico wine for which

this region is renowned. We continue to Assisi, the beautiful city of birds and silence. Before we settle into our hotel, we explore the magnificent Basilica of Santa Maria Degli Angeli (St. Mary of the Angels), where we see the thornless rose bush. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B. Special Lunch. D)

May 3, Sunday, Day 7: ASSISI

Assisi is considered one of Italy's most peaceful spots and a spiritual treasure. The day starts with a visit to the St. Francis Basilica for Mass. We then see the tomb of St. Francis, the world-renowned frescoes of Giotto, and the upper and lower parts of the Basilica with our expert guides before walking the length of the town to the Church of St. Clare. Following lunch, we visit San Damiano. We see the relics of St. Carlo Acutis at the Sanctuary of Esplorazione. In the afternoon, we visit the Ermo della Carceri, St. Francis' retreat hermitage near the summit of Mt. Subasio. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B. D)

May 4, Monday, Day 8: ASSISI – SIENA

Our morning visit is to Siena, where you will see the famous Piazza del Campo, known for its horse races. Later, we see the relics of St. Catherine, the patron Saint of Italy, at St. Dominic Church, where we celebrate Mass. In the afternoon, we return to Assisi for time at leisure and to explore the hilltop town of birds and silence on foot. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B. D)

May 5, Tuesday, Day 9: CASCIA – ROME

We start with a visit to Cascia, home of St. Rita, where we see the Saint's incorrupt body and places associated with her life and work. We celebrate Mass in this holy site and have time for prayer and reflection. Following lunch, we continue to Rome. Dinner and overnight at the hotel near the airport. (B. D)





PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Trip price is based on a minimum of 20 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.18 per Euro is assumed. *A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

SOLO TRAVEL: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/travel accident insurance for every passenger to protect their investment (all payments are non-refundable 60 days before departure). PLEASE NOTE that in most cases travel protection must be purchased within 14 days. Additionally, some options are not available to residents of NY. AIRLINE, SEATING AND CHANGES: To best accommodate our pilgrims, we utilize Group Air Reservations. This affords more predictable space and pricing. However, the airline (not Select International Tours) assigns seats when the group tickets are issued. If you require very specific seats, we suggest you take advantage of the "Land Only" option and book your own airfare. Airline ticket name changes due to missing, incorrect, or incomplete information provided during registration will result in fees of at least \$350 per traveler. Switching reservations from Air and Land to Land Only within 100 days of departure will incur a minimum fee of \$150.00 per person. Quotes for Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request, as are add-ons from your hometown airport.

SPECIAL NEEDS AND REQUESTS: All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be received in writing at least 60 days before departure. People needing a wheelchair should bring their own and travel with a companion who can provide care for them.
