June 21, Monday, Day 1: DEPART FROM USA

We depart on an overnight flight from Pensacola to Rome. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the flights. Optional premium economy and business class quotes are available upon request, starting 120 days before departure. Group air and pricing will be available 10 months before departure. (Please note: specific seat assignments are not possible with group air. You may choose to book your own air if seat location is a priority)

June 22, Tuesday, Day 2: WELCOME TO ITALY – ORVIETO – ASSISI

Our tour guide greets us and assists us with boarding the motorcoach. We embark on a wonderful spiritual journey to Italy's most sacred sites. We are on our way to Assisi, the charming city of birds and silence. Our first stop is the hilltop town of Orvieto, where we have lunch at a local winery and sample the wines of this region. We celebrate Mass at the Cathedral of Orvieto, where the Miracle of the Eucharist of Bolsena is housed. We settle into our hotel and enjoy a well-deserved night of rest. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (L.D)

June 23, Wednesday, Day 3: ASSISI

Our visit to the city of birds and silence includes the Shrine of Renunciation within St. Mary Major church. This shrine was built to commemorate where St. Francis renounced his wealth and family and began his life of poverty and service to the Lord. It is now where the tomb of Saint Carlo Acutis lies. Saint Carlo – the first millennial saint – dedicated part of his short life to cataloging Eucharistic Miracles worldwide. Our visit continues to the Basilica of St. Francis, where we celebrate Mass. We visit the Church of St. Clare and San Damiano, the chapel where Jesus spoke to St. Francis from the crucifix. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B.D)

June 24, Thursday, Day 4: ASSISI

This morning, we visit the St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, the site of the Porziuncola, the tiny church in the woods where St. Francis began his ministry and where St. Clare began her religious life. Mass will be celebrated. In the afternoon, we have free time to enjoy Assisi. Dinner and overnight in Assisi. (B.D)

June 25, Friday, Day 5: LORETO – LANCIANO – SAN GIOVANNI

This morning, we depart for Loreto to see the Holy House of Nazareth, transported here from the Holy Land, as tradition tells us. In it, we view the most reproduced Madonna in the world: the Black Madonna of Loreto. We drive to the sanctuary of the 8th-century Eucharistic Miracle of Lancia. We have time for adoration and a visit to the museum, which details the miracle's history. Here, we celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni. (B.D)

June 26, Saturday, Day 6: SAN GIOVANNI – ST. MICHAEL'S GROTTA

Today, our pilgrimage is dedicated to visiting the places associated with Padre Pio: his tomb and cell, the old church where he received the stigmata, his confessional, and the new church of Santa Maria delle Grazie. We will see the Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel in the afternoon and celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in San Giovanni. (B.D)

June 27, Sunday, Day 7: POMPEII – NAPLES

This morning, a three-hour bus ride awaits us as we travel to Pompeii to visit the Rosary Basilica and celebrate Mass. We enjoy visiting the Bosco de Medici Winery, where we have lunch accompanied by wine. We tour the vineyards and learn about their unique wine production. We have a private tour of the ancient volcanic ruins of Pompeii. We



continue to the magnificent city of Naples. Naples is the home of pizza, so tonight, we will enjoy a pizza dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Naples. (B.Special lunch, Special dinner with wine)

June 28, Monday, Day 8: NAPLES – ROME

We visit the Duomo to see the Chapel of St. Januarius (San Gennaro), the city's main patron saint, and learn about the ongoing miracle of two vials containing San Gennaro's coagulated blood, which liquefies three times a year. We celebrate Mass in this sacred spot before driving to Rome. In the afternoon, we visit St. Paul Outside the Walls and the Tre Fontane Convent next door. Dinner and overnight in Rome. (B.D)

June 29, Tuesday, Day 9: CHRISTIAN ROME

Today, we visit St. Peter's Basilica and the Vatican Museum, including the Sistine Chapel. Following lunch, we visit the Basilica of Saint Mary Major. Here we celebrate Mass. Our next stop is St. John Lateran and the Holy Stairs. The day ends with a visit to the Jesuit Church of Gesu. The rest of the day and the evening are at leisure to explore the historic center, including the nearby Piazza Navona, on our own. Overnight in Rome. (B.L)

June 30, Wednesday, Day 10: ROME – PAPAL AUDIENCE – CATACOMBS

Today, we are blessed by the Holy Father during the Papal Audience. We drive out of the city, stopping at the Chapel of Quo Vadis on the

Appian Way, where we take a few steps along the ancient road that St. Peter and St. Paul would have walked on their way to the Eternal City. Our last stop is the Church of St. Sebastian and the Catacombs, where the early Christians buried their dead, worshiped in secret, and where we celebrate Mass. Tonight, we enjoy a farewell dinner at a traditional Italian restaurant where we can sing along with local music and savor home-cooked dishes and regional wine. Overnight in Rome. (B.Farewell dinner)

July 1, Thursday, Day 11: ROME AT LEISURE

This morning, we celebrate Mass followed by a day at leisure to explore Rome on our own. You may want to visit a museum or explore the city center, but be sure to do some research online to plan your day and purchase museum tickets in advance. Dinner is at leisure. Overnight in Rome. (B)

July 2, Friday, Day 12: RETURN TO USA

This morning, we are transported to Rome airport and our flight home. Lunch and a snack will be served on the flight. (B)

PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Trip price is based on a minimum of 25 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.20 per Euro is assumed. *A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

SOLO TRAVEL: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/travel accident insurance for every passenger to protect their investment (all payments are non-refundable 60 days before departure). PLEASE NOTE that in most cases travel protection must be purchased within 14 days. Additionally, some options are not available to residents of NY. AIRLINE, SEATING AND CHANGES: To best accommodate our pilgrims, we utilize Group Air Reservations. This affords more predictable space and pricing. However, the airline (not Select International Tours) assigns seats when the group tickets are issued. If you require very specific seats, we suggest you take advantage of the "Land Only" option and book your own airfare. Airline ticket name changes due to missing, incorrect, or incomplete information provided during registration will result in fees of at least \$350 per traveler. Switching reservations from Air and Land to Land Only within 100 days of departure will incur a minimum fee of \$250.00 per person. Quotes for Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request, as are add-ons from your hometown airport. We are unable to honor upgrade requests within 100 days of departure.

SPECIAL NEEDS AND REQUESTS: All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be received in writing at least 60 days before departure. People needing a wheelchair should bring their own and travel with a companion who can provide care for them.
