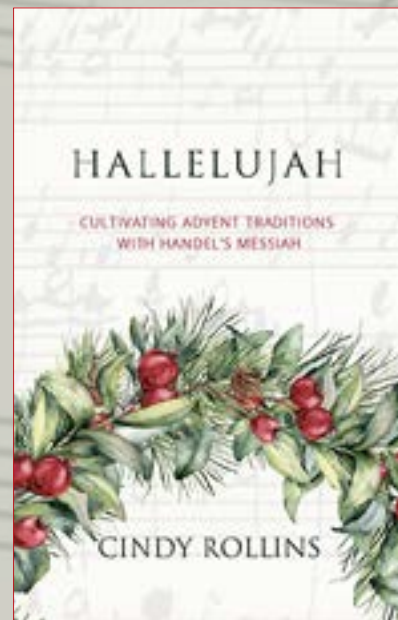

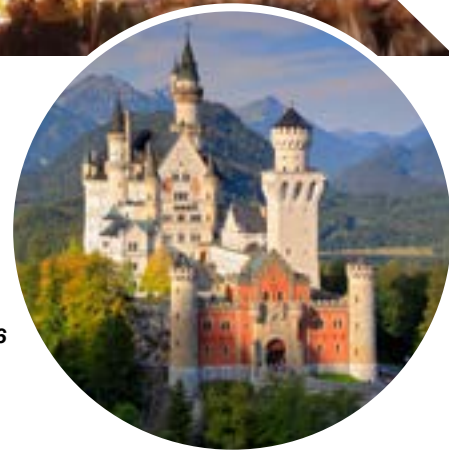

November 28, Saturday, Day 1: DEPART USA TO MUNICH

Depart Newark International Airport on an overnight flight to Munich, Germany. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Quotes for add-on flights and optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades are available upon request, starting 120 days before departure. Group air restrictions do not permit specific seat assignments. If seat location is important to you, we recommend purchasing your own airline tickets and booking the Land Only package with us.

November 29, Sunday, Day 2: MUNICH

We arrive in Munich, board our motorcoach, and head to the city. Our hotel is located in the city center, surrounded by the festive atmosphere of the local Christmas markets. Take a walk to the Christkindlmarkt at Marienplatz for a cup of hot chocolate or Glühwein. This market dates back to the 14th century and is considered the original Christmas Market. Settle into our hotel for our welcome dinner and a well-deserved night of rest. Overnight in Munich. (D)

November 30, Monday, Day 3: MUNICH – CHRISTMAS MARKETS

Following breakfast, we have a two-hour guided walking tour of the city center, followed by a visit to the National Law Library, where we also have a guided tour. We depart for the Christmas Village in the Kaiserhof courtyard of the Residenz city palace. The afternoon is free for lunch and for exploring Munich on your own. Munich Readery is a well-stocked secondhand English bookstore you may wish to visit. There are many markets in the city, each one with a different vibe. Dinner is at leisure, with an opportunity to taste local specialties from the food stalls at the markets. Overnight in Munich. (B)

December 1, Tuesday, Day 4: MUNICH – NEUSCHWANSTEIN – ETTAL BREWERY

This morning, we depart Munich and drive to Neuschwanstein Castle for a visit to the small village and to see the inspiration for Cinderella's Castle in Disney World (outside view). Stop for pictures and hot chocolate. Then drive to the magnificent Ettal Monastery and brewery. After a visit to the beautiful painted baroque Monastery, we tour the brewery for a taste of the brew the monks make here. Following lunch in Ettal, we drive through the woodcarvers' village of Oberammergau, known for its painted houses and numerous Christmas stores, on our way to Salzburg. Dinner is at leisure. Overnight in Salzburg. (B,L)

December 2, Wednesday, Day 5: SALZBURG

Following breakfast, enjoy time at leisure to explore the city on your own. We recommend trying Nockerl – a sweet soufflé served as a dessert, made from egg yolks, flour, sugar, and vanilla - a must for any visitor to the city where The Sound of Music was filmed and where Mozart was born. You may want to buy some Mozartkugeln – small sugar confections made of marzipan and nougat covered with dark chocolate. Visit the Christmas Markets, and sample the food stalls for dinner on your own. This evening, we enjoy a classical music concert in the City of Music. Overnight in Salzburg. (B)

December 3, Thursday, Day 6: SALZBURG – STIFT ADMONT LIBRARY

We travel to Admont today to visit the world's largest monastic library hall. The Stift Admont Library, often called 'The Beauty and the Beast Library' because of its Baroque style and walls painted with frescoes, was the inspiration for Disney animators. Featuring towering

shelves with over 200,000 books, a soaring ceiling, and a white-and-gold color scheme, many consider this library one of the most beautiful in the world. Located in the Austrian Alps, it is an 18th-century masterpiece. We have a guided tour of the library and time to visit the art museum located in the monastery, have lunch in the Abbey restaurant, and enjoy some time to shop in the gift store. Dinner and overnight in the area. (B.L.D)

December 4, Friday, Day 7: MELK – VIENNA

In the morning, we drive to Melk, a small town in Austria along the Danube. We explore Melk Abbey, which was the setting for Umberto Eco's novel, *The Name of the Rose*. Among the treasures housed here are paintings, sculptures, and decorative art from the 9th to 15th centuries. We see the Abbey, tour the Library, and explore the gorgeous town of Melk on the Danube River, with its Renaissance homes and winding streets reminiscent of the Middle Ages. Late in the afternoon, we arrive in Vienna and settle into our hotel. Dinner is at leisure with an opportunity to visit one of the many Christmas markets. Overnight in Vienna. (B)



December 5, Saturday, Day 8: VIENNA – CHRISTMAS MARKETS

Enjoy breakfast in the hotel. Our tour of the imperial city includes a panoramic tour of the Ringstrasse area, during which we can appreciate the majesty of Vienna. We walk to St. Stephen's Cathedral (outside view), followed by a 60-minute guided walking tour of the city center, including Donners' Fountain, Belvedere Palace Gardens, and Hofburg Palace. Our visit includes the Austrian National Library, a remarkable art collection in a beautiful setting. In the afternoon, we recommend you visit Schonbrunn Palace to see the light show and have time at the beautiful Christmas Market. Tonight we enjoy dinner in Grinzing – a part of Vienna

known for its vineyards – and taste local wine together. (B. Farewell dinner)

December 6, Sunday, Day 9: VIENNA – USA

This morning we are transferred to the airport for our flights home. (B)

PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Trip price is based on a minimum of 25 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.20 per Euro is assumed. *A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

SOLO TRAVEL: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/travel accident insurance for every passenger to protect their investment (all payments are non-refundable 60 days before departure). PLEASE NOTE that in most cases travel protection must be purchased within 14 days. Additionally, some options are not available to residents of NY. AIRLINE, SEATING AND CHANGES: To best accommodate our pilgrims, we utilize Group Air Reservations. This affords more predictable space and pricing. However, the airline (not Select International Tours) assigns seats when the group tickets are issued. If you require very specific seats, we suggest you take advantage of the "Land Only" option and book your own airfare. Airline ticket name changes due to missing, incorrect, or incomplete information provided during registration will result in fees of at least \$350 per traveler. Switching reservations from Air and Land to Land Only within 100 days of departure will incur a minimum fee of \$150.00 per person. Quotes for Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request, as are add-ons from your hometown airport.

SPECIAL NEEDS AND REQUESTS: All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be received in writing at least 60 days before departure. People needing a wheelchair should bring their own and travel with a companion who can provide care for them.
