February 27, Saturday, Day 1: DEPART FROM USA

We depart Denver International Airport on an overnight flight to Lisbon. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Quotes for add-on flights and optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades are available upon request. Due to group air restrictions, we cannot request specific seat assignments on flights. If you prefer to choose your seat on the plane, please book land-only with us and book your own airfare separately.

February 28, Sunday, Day 2: LISBON – SANTARÉM – FÁTIMA

Upon arrival in Lisbon, we are greeted by Select International's English-speaking tour manager, who will accompany the group during the entire pilgrimage. We board the coach and depart for the ancient city of Santarém, where we visit the Church of St. Stephen, which contains one of the oldest recorded Eucharistic miracles, venerated since the 13th century. We celebrate Mass at this holy site. Continue to Fátima for dinner and overnight. **Meals: D**

March 1, Monday, Day 3: FÁTIMA

After breakfast, we begin our visit to Fátima, which includes the Basilica, the site of the children's graves, the Village of Aljustrel, where they lived, and Valinhos, the site of Our Lady's appearance after the children's return from prison. Experience Christ's love as you walk and follow the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way), culminating in the Chapel of Calvary, which overlooks all of Fátima. Join your prayers with those of pilgrims from around the world as you pray for the sick and drink water from the miraculous well. Attend the blessing of the sick and participate in nightly candlelight processions. We celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in Fátima. **Meals: B, D**

March 2, Tuesday, Day 4: FÁTIMA – ÁVILA

Early this morning, we depart for Ávila, Spain, the magnificent walled city dedicated to St. Teresa of Ávila, the great mystic and one of the first women to be named a Doctor of the Church. We visit La Santa Convent (Convent of St. Teresa), built on the house where St. Teresa was born, and the Monastery of the Incarnation (La Encarnación Convent), where St. Teresa became a nun and is now the home of the

most comprehensive museum dedicated to her life. In the museum, you may see various relics and the stairs where she is said to have encountered the Child Jesus. At Ávila Cathedral, which also contains many of St. Teresa's relics, we celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in Ávila. **Meals: B, D**

March 3, Wednesday, Day 5: ÁVILA – ALBA DE TORMES

This morning, we drive along the pilgrimage route "From the cradle to the grave" which links the cities of Ávila and Alba de Tormes, which many pilgrims walk as they are walking in the footprints of the Restless Saint. In Alba de Tormes, the origin of the Noble House of Alba, we see where Saint Teresa died on October 4, 1582. Our visit includes Mass at the convent of La Anunciación (The Annunciation), which keeps her sepulcher, as well as the great relics of her heart and left arm. We return to Ávila and have the afternoon at leisure to explore the walled city. Dinner and overnight in Ávila. **Meals: B, D**

March 4, Thursday, Day 6: ÁVILA – GARABANDAL

This morning we visit Cuatro Postes (Four Columns), the site which commemorates the time when a seven-year-old St. Teresa convinced her brother to run away with her to seek martyrdom; their uncle caught them here and returned them home. We celebrate Mass in Ávila at the Basilica of San Vicente, which stands on the site of St. Vincent's martyrdom. Departing Ávila, we drive through Northern Spain into the mountains to San Sebastián de Garabandal, where we are greeted by our friends at the Divine Will Center. After a warm welcome, we settle into our accommodations, enjoy a simple but delicious dinner, and spend the night. **Meals: B, D**

March 5, Friday, Day 7: GARABANDAL – SERVANT OF GOD LUISA PICCARRETA BIRTHDAY IN HEAVEN

Today, we journey to San Sebastian de Garabandal, where Mary appeared to 4 young seers. We will enjoy three nights at the Divine Mercy Retreat Center with our American host, Anne Weigel. She will lead us to the many apparition sites, introduce us to experts on the apparitions, and help us celebrate the heavenly birthday of Servant of God Luisa Piccarreta. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight stay in Garabandal. **Meals: B, L, D**



March 6, Saturday, Day 8: GARABANDAL

We have a day of prayer and personal reflection, as well as talks by Fr. Windsor. Mass will be celebrated. Overnight in Garabandal. **Meals: B, L, D**

March 7, Sunday, Day 9: GARABANDAL – LOURDES

Following breakfast, we depart for Lourdes, a great pilgrimage center where more than four million pilgrims, many of whom are sick or disabled, come to bathe in the waters of the miraculous spring. In 1858, 14-year-old Bernadette Soubirous declared that the Virgin had appeared to her several times in the Cave of Massabielle. She had said to her in the local patois, "I am the Immaculate Conception." This evening, you may want to participate in the candlelight procession. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. **Meals: B, D**

March 8 & 9, Monday & Tuesday, Days 10 & 11: OUR LADY OF LOURDES

Following an early breakfast, we visit the Basilica of St. Pius X, the world's largest underground sanctuary, which can accommodate more than 25,000 people. See the Church of the Rosary, whose walls are

covered with marble tablets of gratitude commemorating cures and other favors attained through the intercession of Our Lady at her Grotto in Lourdes. The walking tour includes the sites associated with Bernadette's life in Lourdes, particularly the Cachot, the former prison where her impoverished family was housed in one room during the apparitions. After lunch on your own, you have time to bathe in the healing waters of the miraculous Fountain or follow the Way of the Cross up the hill to the Cross of Calvary. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. **Meals: B, D**

March 10, Wednesday, Day 12: RETURN TO USA

Early this morning, we will transfer you to Toulouse airport for your return flight to the USA. (B)

PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Trip price is based on a minimum of 15 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.20 per Euro is assumed. *A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

SOLO TRAVEL: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/travel accident insurance for every passenger to protect their investment (all payments are non-refundable 60 days before departure). PLEASE NOTE that in most cases travel protection must be purchased within 14 days. Additionally, some options are not available to residents of NY. AIRLINE, SEATING AND CHANGES: To best accommodate our pilgrims, we utilize Group Air Reservations. This affords more predictable space and pricing. However, the airline (not Select International Tours) assigns seats when the group tickets are issued. If you require very specific seats, we suggest you take advantage of the "Land Only" option and book your own airfare. Airline ticket name changes due to missing, incorrect, or incomplete information provided during registration will result in fees of at least \$350 per traveler. Switching reservations from Air and Land to Land Only within 100 days of departure will incur a minimum fee of \$250.00 per person. Quotes for Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request, as are add-ons from your hometown airport. We are unable to honor upgrade requests within 100 days of departure.

SPECIAL NEEDS AND REQUESTS: All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be received in writing at least 60 days before departure. People needing a wheelchair should bring their own and travel with a companion who can provide care for them.
