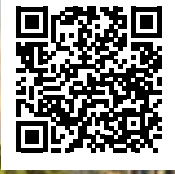

May 11, Tuesday, Day 1: DEPART FROM USA

We depart on an overnight flight from Denver to Lisbon. Dinner and breakfast are served on the plane. Quotes for add-on flights and optional Premium Economy and Business Class upgrades are available upon request. Due to group air restrictions, we are not able to request specific seats on the flights. You may wish to book your own air and purchase the Land Only package if you prefer to pre-arrange your seats on the flights.

May 12, Wednesday, Day 2: LISBON – SANTAREM – FÁTIMA

Upon arrival in Lisbon, we are greeted by Select International's English-speaking tour manager, who will accompany the group during the entire pilgrimage. We board the coach and depart for the ancient city of Santarém, where we visit the Church of St. Stephen, which contains one of the oldest recorded Eucharistic miracles, venerated since the 13th century. We celebrate Mass at this holy site. Continue to Fátima for dinner and overnight. **Meals: D**

May 13, Thursday, Day 3: FÁTIMA

After breakfast, we begin our visit to Fátima, which includes the Basilica, the site of the children's graves, the Village of Aljustrel, where they lived, and Valinhos, the site of Our Lady's appearance after the children's return from prison. Experience Christ's love as you walk and follow the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra (The Sacred Way), culminating in the Chapel of Calvary, which overlooks all of Fátima. Join your prayers with those of pilgrims from around the world as you pray for the sick and drink water from the miraculous well. Attend the blessing of the sick and participate in nightly candlelight processions. Mass will be celebrated. Tonight, we will have a special dinner with wine to celebrate Fr. Nick's 10-year priestly ordination anniversary. Overnight in Fátima. **Meals: B. Special Dinner**

May 14, Friday, Day 4: LISBON – MARSEILLE

This morning we depart towards Lisbon for a flight to Marseille. Upon arrival in Marseille, we visit the Basilica of St. Victor, home to an ancient crypt tied to the tradition that St. Mary Magdalene, who, along with Lazarus and Martha, landed on the shores of Provence before making her way inland to the cave at La Sainte-Baume. We also visit the Cathedral of St. Mary Major, which is both the largest Cathedral in France and the last Cathedral built in the country. Here we celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in the area. **Meals: B.D**

May 15, Saturday, Day 5: BOUME – THE CAVE OF ST. MARY MAGDALEN

A long but beautiful day awaits us as we travel to visit la Grotte de la Sainte Baume to see the cave of Mary Magdalene. After a 45-minute walk up the hill, we see the cave and the chapel erected at the entrance. The story of how Mary Magdalene ended up in this part of the town is quite extraordinary. After landing in what is today the town of Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer (named after her), she traveled through Provence, evangelizing the region. She made her way to a cave on Saint Baume Mountain, where she spent the last thirty years of her life. She was buried in the nearby town of Saint-Maximin, named after the disciple Maximin, who also came with her to Provence. We descend to the Basilica of St. Maximin, where her relics, including the reliquary of her skull, are venerated to this day, and celebrate Mass at this holy site. Mass will be celebrated. Dinner and overnight in the area. **Meals: B.D**

May 16, Sunday, Day 6: LYON – ARS

Today, we travel to Ars, stopping first in Lyon, where we have a visit to the magnificent Cathedral of Our Lady overlooking the city. We continue to Ars to visit the Shrine of the "Cure de Ars," St. John Vianney, the patron Saint of Parish Priests. Following Mass at the Shrine, we check into our hotel. Dinner and overnight in Macon. **Meals: B.D**



May 17, Monday, Day 7: PARAY LE-MONIAL

Our motorcoach takes us to Paray Le-Monial, the cradle of the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, where we celebrate Mass, and have a full day of prayer and devotion, including Holy Hour. Our Lord Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque to reveal His Sacred Heart in this sacred spot. We visit the convent and the parish church. Dinner and overnight in Macon. **Meals: B.D**

May 18, Tuesday, Day 8: NEVERS – PARIS

After breakfast, our journey takes us to Nevers to visit the Convent of St. Gildard, where the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette reposes. After being blessed with eighteen apparitions of the Virgin Mary in Lourdes, St. Bernadette moved to Nevers, where she received her religious habit in 1866. We have lunch at the convent in Nevers and celebrate Mass before we continue to Paris for a late afternoon arrival. Settle into our hotel and have dinner at leisure to explore the many different eateries in the city. Overnight in Paris. **Meals: B.L**

May 19, Wednesday, Day 9: PARIS – SEINE RIVER CRUISE

Following breakfast, we embark on an immersive city tour of Paris. We start with a visit to the artistic Montmartre district, where we discover its bohemian spirit and explore the breathtaking Sacré-Cœur Basilica, and celebrate Mass. We have time for lunch before visiting the newly rebuilt Notre-Dame Cathedral, a testament to resilience. Later enjoy a panoramic tour of iconic landmarks including the Eiffel Tower. We also visit Église de la Madeleine, the striking neoclassical church dedicated

to St. Mary Magdalene, bringing our pilgrimage's Provençal thread full circle in the heart of the capital. Tonight, prepare for a magical experience: a farewell dinner cruise on the Seine River. As we glide past the magnificently lit buildings, the city's beauty unfolds before us, culminating in the dazzling light show of the Eiffel Tower. Overnight in Paris.

Meals: B. Special Dinner

May 20, Thursday, Day 10: PARIS – CHARTRES

Today, we visit the beautiful Chapel of the Miraculous Medal, walk a few steps and behold the incorrupt body of St. Vincent de Paul at the chapel of Maison-Mère. Then we drive outside the city to visit the village of Chartres where we have lunch and see the magnificent Cathedral of Notre-Dame and its incredible 12th and 13th century stained-glass windows. We celebrate Mass, explore the Cathedral and the Crypt, and venerate the relic on display in Chartres Cathedral, believed to be Mary's Veil, also known as Sancta Camisa. It is a silk cloth believed to be the tunic the Virgin Mary wore at the time of Jesus' birth, and has been a central relic for the cathedral since it was gifted by King Charles the Bald in 876. The relic was miraculously found unharmed after a fire in 1194, which led to the rebuilding of the current cathedral. We return to Paris for dinner and overnight. **Meals: B.D**

May 21, Friday, Day 11: RETURN TO USA

Today marks the end of our pilgrimage. We say farewell to a country and a trip that will last in our memory forever. We are transferred to the airport for our return flight home. **Meals: B**

- Your passport must be valid through November 21, 2027.

PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Trip price is based on a minimum of 25 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.20 per Euro is assumed. *A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

SOLO TRAVEL: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/travel accident insurance for every passenger to protect their investment (all payments are non-refundable 60 days before departure). PLEASE NOTE that in most cases travel protection must be purchased within 14 days. Additionally, some options are not available to residents of NY. AIRLINE, SEATING AND CHANGES: To best accommodate our pilgrims, we utilize Group Air Reservations. This affords more predictable space and pricing. However, the airline (not Select International Tours) assigns seats when the group tickets are issued. If you require very specific seats, we suggest you take advantage of the "Land Only" option and book your own airfare. Airline ticket name changes due to missing, incorrect, or incomplete information provided during registration will result in fees of at least \$350 per traveler. Switching reservations from Air and Land to Land Only within 100 days of departure will incur a minimum fee of \$250.00 per person. Quotes for Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request, as are add-ons from your hometown airport. We are unable to honor upgrade requests within 100 days of departure.

SPECIAL NEEDS AND REQUESTS: All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be received in writing at least 60 days before departure. People needing a wheelchair should bring their own and travel with a companion who can provide care for them.

WALKING: Our trips require daily walking, sometimes up or down slopes, steps, and uneven terrain. We recommend preparing by walking before the trip.
